

elbows. That's right, it carries as many as 9 people in comfort and style.


The Bus actually gives you 70% more room inside than a full-sized domestic station wagon. And almost as much

The VW Bus also comes with an electric rear window defogger, a fold-down rear seat, and cushioned and insulated floor mats.



From the big, comfortable driver's seat you'll get an unobstructed view of the road ahead and a close-up one of the heavily padded dashboard. 


the kids, there's the optional pop-up top that gives you accommodations for up to five.






