Original Volkswagen seating

The Volkswagen Station Wagon comes equipped with excellent seats. They are contoured. And breathable.

The front seats are sporty, adjustable, bucket seats. There is a side-to-side back seat wide enough for three adults. With plenty of room to spare. And safety belts are standard.

A handy walk-through aisle connects the cab seats with the cabin seat.

In fact, the original VW seats are so good that there just isn't any way to improve them.

So we use them.

A bedtime story

The most basic part of any camper is its bed. But not all camper beds are comfortable.

Sometimes you end up having to sleep on a slope . . . because most camper beds aren't adjustable. Some are bumpy . . . because they use several cushions. Some are even sticky . . . because their cushions don't breathe.

So, we made our bed from all of the features that the other beds lack. Ours is adjustable. It has a smooth one-piece mattress. And, the mattress is breathable. We made it comfortable.

Because it's a bed.



Popless top

Some tops pop. Ours doesn't.

Pop tops, after popping, provide lots of standing room.

Ours does too. But without popping.

The Adventurer top provides more than just standing room.

It also provides a huge "attic" with 25 cu. ft. of extra inside storage space. And that's a lot of space . . . There is even room inside for long awkward things like skis and fishing poles.

At the very highest spot in the ceiling, we have installed an efficient wind-pressure adjusted roof vent. And there are two long awning-type screened windows to let fresh breezes in. And keep rain and insects out.

Another advantage of a popless top is that it can be beautifully paneled. And well insulated too.

All of this helps keep your portable house cooler.

You also get a recessed ceiling light. And, in the Adventurer IV, there is a 12V outlet for our fully adjustable marine-quality fan.

As you can see, the Adventurer top provides you with a lot more than just standing room. So a popless top might just be your top choice.



When you look down . . .

. . . things really look up. This bird's eye view shows you the Adventurer IV's fully equipped galley.

Notice that there is room for four people to dine in comfort. Without crowding. And still another can dine up front using our portable snack table. Several tables give you several possibilities. (Like separating the kids.)

The Adventurer IV has features that you usually expect to find only in high cost luxury motor homes.

Like pressurized water for instance. And a city water inlet. We even put in an Everpure water purification system to assure that your water supply is both safe and good-tasting.

This purified water is available at your tap without pumping.

And there is hot water too. A special stainless steel container delivers gravity-fed hot running water at your sink.

To make cooking convenient we supply a built-in propane range. And supply the range with a propane tank big enough to last you for a month's vacation.

But we didn't stop here.

110V wiring is standard. And so is an electric refrigerator with cross-top freezer. And we provide you with a special heavy-duty battery just to run the refrigerator. The battery is charged automatically as you drive.

Stored between your two front seats is a portable seat with a built-in chemical toilet. An Adventure Camper exclusive.

You'll also find a full-length closet and an abundance of storage space for all of the things you need.

(Even for things you don't need.)



Your blueprint to Adventure -

The Adventurer IV top is made of fiberglass. It has a smooth, pearl white gel-coat finish which looks good and reflects the heat.

Your Top includes a large, moulded-in luggage rack.

There are two long hollow fins with access from the inside of your vehicle. These are good for storing the really important things, such as fishing poles and skis. . . .

Little things a big problem? Here's a cabinet to solve it.

For a good day, start with a good night. The breathable one-piece mattress, complete with fitted bedding, unfolds into a comfortable full width double bed in just five seconds. Our exclusive, fully adjustable suspension straps permit you to raise or lower the head-section to compensate for uneven parking . . . and that beats leveling the entire vehicle!

Volkswagen makes your seats, front and back. They do such a nice job, we couldn't find any reason to change them . . . they are both contoured and breathable, and the original safety belts are retained.


This traveling-home has two batteries. A big one and a little one. The little one runs the big car and the big one runs the little refrigerator. They are both charged automatically through a solid state dual diode charging system.

Smooth, four wheel torsion bar independent suspension with double jointed rear axle absorbs bumps one at a time. This, combined with high road clearance, gives you an ideal vehicle for your off-the-highway Adventures.


Yes, there is a 110V outlet and a 25' weatherproof extension cord is standard equipment. There are two small 12V interior lights and one bright 2-tube flourescent reading light. A 12V outlet is also standard.

Slipped between your two front seats is a portable chemical toilet-filler cushion. In this position it provides an extra seat — facing either forward or backward.

Our 2.4 gal. propane bottle has the operating capacity of 20 little propane bottles. And, you can fill it for the price of one.

the Volkswagen Adventurer IV

This is a special roof vent. You don't adjust it. The wind does. Why not let the wind work for you? A 12V adjustable ceiling fan is located near the vent. This same fan can be used at your dash.

The Adventurer IV gives you six feet of interior headroom. There's lots of inside storing-room, too — approximately 25 cubic feet of it. Could you use an extra 25 cubic feet of inside storage space on your next camping trip?

Here are two large, screened windows. One on the right side and one on the left side. They are good for letting the breeze in, or locking the wind out. And, since they are awning-style windows, you can ventilate on a rainy day.

Here is the closet. It is both longer and wider than the old-style closet located beside the back seat — and, it doesn't eliminate the use of the rear side window.

This unique stainless steel container gives you hot running water at your sink, at a touch. And its lid is recessed — a good place to keep a hot pot hot!

There is a difference between a sink and a salad bowl. Real sinks have drains. Like this one. It's made of stainless steel too.

Your stove and butane system are built in. This is a traveling-home, not a camping-car.


Tired of sharing your bed with a tire? We put it right up front and include both lock and cover. In this position it is easy to get at, and provides extra collision protection. Looks sporty too!

Here is a utensil drawer. There is nothing special about it unless it's missing.


This is a refrigerator. You don't buy ice for it, it makes ice for you.

We've given you a table for outside use. When it isn't a table, it becomes a door for a storage cabinet. There are three more tables inside.

Your water, supplied through an exterior city-water inlet, is stored in a 14 gallon air-pressurized tank, and an Everpure water purification system is standard equipment. We have replaced the old-fashioned pump with a faucet. The frontier effort is gone but not the spirit.

We have a good selection of accessories too. Like snap-on screens for the cab windows. And hammocks. And tents. And all the goodies that are standard on the Adventurer IV can be added to our other models.



Our covered wagon

Well, not really a covered wagon in the literal sense. Or a car either — because it makes more sense. And some people would think you senseless if you tried to call it a motor home. Still, as a motor home, they have to admit that it does a pretty good job — without being a job to drive. Or park. Our covered wagon is nearly as maneuverable as a VW Bug.

And that's pretty maneuverable.

When the going gets really rough, Adventure's covered wagon is at its best. If you take it where adventurers go, you will see mostly jeeps, and Bugs, and other Adventurers. Your high ground clearance lets you straddle boulders up to 9" high. Rear engine traction carries you over sand and snow that would stop more conventional vehicles. And the air-cooled engine can't boil or freeze. As for economy, you can cover over five miles per quart — not gallon. It is the only motor home with all four wheels independently suspended by torsion bars. And double jointed rear axles give it maximum roadability on curvy bumpy roads. But there's nothing really remarkable about that.

Unless you've never heard of a Volkswagen.

This is the answer for people who, although they dream of travel and camping, end up staying at home. With an Adventurer IV covered wagon, you can stay at home while traveling. And dream about traveling while traveling. The way we look at it, this is the cheapest way of staying home.


And, it is also the cheapest way of traveling.




