





## THIS YEAR'S VW STATION WAGON. A GOOD THING MADE BETTER.



raise the roof. You'll find VW's pop-up top very accommodating for a family of five. Sets up in seconds and makes sleeping room for two more adults.



Pound for pound, feature for feature, the newlydecorated Campmobile has what it takes to put the fun back in driving, camping and living.





















## WHEN IT COMES TO SERVICING YOUR VW, WE'VE MADE A GOOD THING EVEN BETTER.


We call it the VW Owner's Security Blanket, and it's just about the best coverage you can find.

#### VOLKSWAGEN OWNER'S SECURITY BLANKET\*

If an owner maintains and services his 1975 Volkswagen as prescribed in the Volkswagen Maintenance Schedule, any factory part found to be defective in material or workmanship within 12 months or 20,000 miles, whichever comes first, will be repaired or replaced by any U.S. or Canadian VW dealer. And this will be done free of charge (fluids, maintenance service and filter replacements are at the expense of the vehicle owner).

In addition, VWoA warrants every internal engine and transmission part against defects in material and workmanship for 24 months or 24,000 miles, whichever comes first.

As part of the VW Owner's Security Blanket, VW dealers will make every effort to provide qualified owners, by appointment, with substitute transportation without charge (subject to availability) whenever a new vehicle warranty repair cannot be completed on the day scheduled.

Furthermore, VW dealers provide Express Care Service for repairs of 30 minutes or less, while you wait.

VWoA warrants every new and factory rebuilt part and accessory distributed by VWoA and sold by authorized VW dealers in the U.S. and Canada to be free from defects under normal use for a period of 6 months or 6,000 miles, whichever comes first (excluding normal wear and tear, maintenance and service items). Any authorized VW dealer will replace or repair defective parts free of charge including labor cost.
