



With standard front disc brakes and power assist on all four wheels, you stop as well as you go.


The VW Station Wagon's welded unibody is triply protected with anti-corrosive and primer underneath the finish. Which means that years of eating up the road won't eat away your car.


















# THE '76 CAMPMOBILE. IT COMBINES THE BEST FEATURES OF THREE CARS AND A HOUSE.






